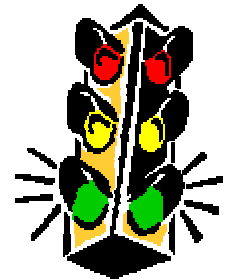
Transportation Facts

Our 23 buses transport 2500 students each day on 186 separate scheduled runs, traveling 500,000 home to school miles each year. Additionally, our buses travel 50,000 miles on athletic and educational field trips.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS

Our state certified school bus drivers must complete the following requirements before they are permitted to transport our students on our school buses.

- Minimum 20 hours of Classroom Instruction given by a State Certified Instructor
- Minimum 20 hours of Behind the Wheel Instruction given by a State Certified Instructor
- Successful completion of written tests at the DMV and CHP
- Successful completion of drive test at the CHP
- Possession of required licenses and certificates
- Clean DMV driving record
- Thorough background check with the Department of Justice
- Physical examination every two years
- Successful completion of a pre-employment drug test as well as continuous random drug and alcohol testing throughout their employment with the district



Our school buses are inspected daily by the school bus driver. Defects are noted and repaired by our vehicle maintenance staff. The California Highway Patrol inspects each bus at least once each year to ascertain that it is in compliance with all safety rules and regulations as set forth by the State of California.
