- Your tax and parent tax information; previous year taxes are okay for now if you don't have 2017 tax information completed.
- Any records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, workers comp, disability benefits, or child support received or paid.
- Any records of value of Business/Investments/Assets (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending.

#### CA Dream Act Applicants

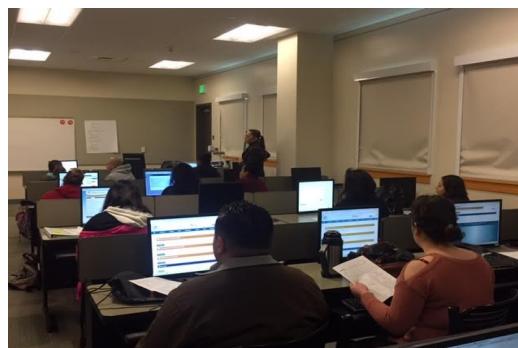
- Your 2017 W-2's.
- Parent's 2017 W-2's.
- Your tax and parent tax information; previous year taxes are okay for now if you don't have 2017 tax information completed.
- Any records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, child support received or paid, etc.
- Any records of value of Business/Investments/Assets (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending.

The FREE Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) / CA Dream Act Application is a required form for all students wishing to receive financial aid whether you want to attend a four-year college/university, community college, vocational, or technical college.
