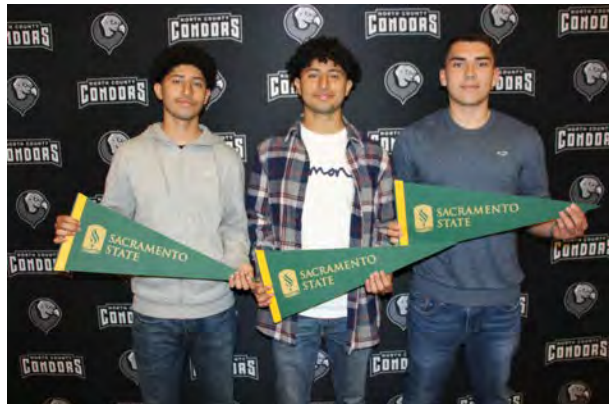


Superintendent's Report – May 9, 2019

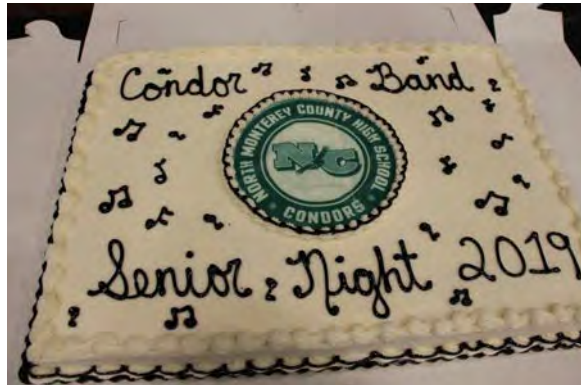
Joel Espinoza and Nina Harrison will attend Hartnell College this fall.

Wednesday, May 1 **NMCHS**- Senior Band concert featured the Jazz Band and Condor band. Seniors were given recognition and awards.

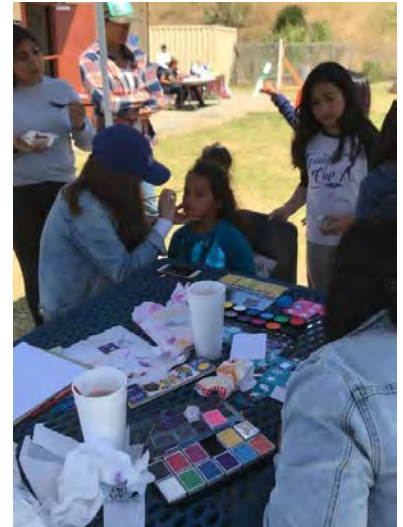
