Description This course will help high school students understand keys to success by building Analytical, Creative, and Practical Skills in order to achieve success in academics, Police and the Fire Academy. This course also allows the student to explore what types of public service careers they may want to achieve in.	Description This course will acquaint the high school student with all aspects of our criminal justice system, which will include the history, roles, process theories, and many other aspects of the criminal justice system. Other course topics will include: Professional orientation, ethics, intro to criminal law, laws of arrest, evidence, search and seizures, investigations, community relations, verbal and written communication, arrest techniques, cultural diversity and discrimination, use of force, arrest techniques. Students will also receive their CPR, First Aid, and AED cards.	Description This is the final course or sequence for the Public Service. This course student will apply Level I and Level II into actual application. Student will have an opportunity to either job Shadow or internship with different agencies such as the Security, Police, and Fire Industries. Student will then take their experience and share it with the class as a PowerPoint presentation or as an Expository paper.
